TAMPA, Fla. (Nov. 9, 2023) – Today, the Florida Policy Project released *Improving Veterans' Incarceration and Reentry in Florida*, *Leaving No Veteran Behind*. Best practices include improving incarceration and reentry for veterans in Florida's prisons, expanding identification efforts and data dissemination of veterans in Florida's prisons, and connecting veterans with eligible benefits through innovative strategies and early identification.

The Florida Policy Project is data-driven and focused on creating better outcomes to support our veterans, providing tools for reentry, and saving money for Florida's taxpayers. Over 72% of veterans incarcerated in Florida prisons are over the age of 50. Facilities that house more people over the age of 50 spend 14 times more on prescription drugs and five times more on medical care.

"Having served our country, I believe we can do better for our veterans. Bringing best practices to Florida will ensure no veteran is left behind," said Florida Policy Project founder, CEO, and former Senator Jeff Brandes.
